

Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports



- **121 Kindness Acts** were submitted between Nov. 1st & Jan. 30th
- There were **638 BIRs (Behavior Incident Report)** between Nov. 1st & Jan. 30th
- Most **BIRs** occurred during **circle/large group time (25%** of total BIRs)

Medical Homes

Linking families to a "medical home" or a primary care provider is crucial because they provide prevention services, coordinate needed services, and help families learn the best way to help their child grow up healthy.

94% of enrolled families this quarter have an established medical home.



Teaching Strategies GOLD

Three times per school year, Preschool Teachers at CenClear complete developmental assessments on children. Assessments are done using observation (what is seen naturally in the classroom) on 38 research-based objectives.

Children can either **Meet** Expectations, **Exceed** Expectations, or score **Below** Expectations on the assessments.

COR Advantage

Three times per school year, Early Head Start Home Visitors at CenClear complete developmental assessments on children. Assessments are done using observation (what is seen naturally in the home) on 8 content areas and 34 key concepts.

Observations are scored on a scale from 0 -7 and then compared to national averages. Children's assessment scores can fall **below** age-level norms, **meet** age-level norms, or reach **above** age-level norms.
