Supporting Infant/Toddler Peer Relationships

Social experiences during the infant and toddler years set the stage for later friendships and peer relationships. Early interactions introduce children to important social skills like sharing, turn-taking, empathy, and back-and-forth conversation.

As children get older, their earliest relationships will become a source of self-esteem that reinforces their sense of belonging.
