Make the most of a preschooler's summer by blending playful learning with flexible routines. Keep core habits intact: Keep wake-up, meal, and rest times consistent. Keep babies under six months strictly out of direct sunlight and avoid using sunscreen. For all infants, prevent overheating by staying indoors during peak sun hours, dressing them in single, lightweight cotton layers, and keeping them well-hydrated via frequent breastfeeding or formula.
