

Magic Ratio

5:1 PARENTING RULE

The "MAGIC RATIO" parenting rule states that for every 1 negative interaction with a child (or anyone in your life), there are 5 positive interactions. This rule can help promote STRONG, HEALTHY relationships.

Examples of negative responses yelling, criticizing, overly corrective, sarcasm

Examples of positive responses: providing praise, validating feelings, be affectionate, happy faces

Tips:

Gestures/Facial expressions can quickly alert a child to your feelings-be mindful of how you LOOK in addition to how you RESPOND.

Look for the POSITIVE in the Negative. Changing your perspective or "flipping the script", can lead to teachable moments.

Take notes on your ratio numbers. Make small goals for additional positive interactions to be added over a period of time.
