Winter Safety Tips

- Prevent carbon monoxide poisoning: Install a CO detector, never use a gas oven to heat your home, and only use kerosene heaters with a window slightly open.
- Prevent frozen pipes: Let hot and cold water trickle from faucets, open cabinet doors under sinks, and leave the heat on at a consistent temperature. If you are away, drain and shut off the water system, or have someone check the house daily.
- Use heating safely: Place space heaters on a level, hard surface and keep flammable items at least three feet away. If using a fireplace, use a screen to catch sparks
